<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to current Hogsback Road Crew (Captains and Marshals) who have completed Advanced Riding and first aid courses The existing post holder
<b>Duties</b>	<p>Responsible for anticipating, publishing and responding to membership issues on safe riding, group riding, safety-related bike maintenance, and rider training. This is a key post working with the Head Road Captain and director to enable a safe and fun chapter riding culture in the chapter and road crew.</p> <p>Attendance and reporting is expected at Quarterly meetings and all major Chapter events.</p>
<b>Skills/Interests</b>	<p>Interest in improving the safety-related riding and first aid skills across the whole membership. Able to advise on external riding and skills improvement training, and organise first aid training courses for all Road Crew as well as potentially other members.
