<b>Post/Type</b>	Membership Officer/Discretionary
<b>Reason</b>	Step down of previous Officer, due to moving abroad
<b>Term</b>	3 years, renewable
<b>Start</b>	September 2018
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to any full Chapter member who has regularly participated in Chapter events as rider or pillion for at least 12 months, and who is not a member of another Chapter.
<b>Duties</b>	<p>Responsible for the timely checking and processing of new and annual renewal applications; keeping an accurate and up to date membership register; providing first contact and guidance for new members; checking HOG memberships are current and following up late renewals; acting as Returning Officer at any full Chapter votes for Primary Officers. Duties also include meeting and greeting new members at club night when available and introducing them around the chapter.</p> <p>The appointment entails full membership of the Committee.
