Definition of recognised and approved activities covered under BMF affiliated clubs' insurance

BMF Liability Insurance

In order for an event, held by an affiliated club, to be covered under the BMF Liability Insurance that event must be approved by the BMF and the club must follow the BMF Guidelines.

In order to avoid unnecessary applications for the BMF approval, it had been agreed with Howden that the BMF will define those events that are considered Routine Club Events. These events will then be approved events without the need for an approval application, so long as the club holding the event follows the BMF Guidelines.

Within each insured club there must be a clear understanding as to those having the authority to approve events and thereby make them Official Club Events.

BMF Routine Club Events

The events, which fall into this category, are as follows:

- Official Club Meetings or Regional Meetings of Other Gatherings, which are approved by and organised for the affiliated club, where competition, speed or time are not involved.
- Road Runs (including tours organised over more than one day) which are approved by and organised for the affiliated club, except where the motorcycle is being used in competition or mechanically propelled under its own power.
- Off Tarmac Events which are approved by and organised for the affiliated club, except where the motorcycle is being used in competition or mechanically propelled under its own power.
- Camping Events, Club and National Rallies which are approved by and organised for the affiliated club, where competition, speed time are not involved.
- Club Stands, which are approved by, and organised for, the affiliated club at Motorcycle Shows and Exhibitions organised by others.
- Motorcycle Shows and Exhibitions, which are approved by and organised for the affiliated club.
- Any combination of the above
- Joint Events organised with other clubs, who are also affiliated to the BMF and which meet the criteria in all the above points.

N.B. The exclusion of competition mentioned above does not apply to on site entertainment at an event (such as quiz, party games, and field games) and Concours d'Elegance, where the competitive element is based on the appearance.

Other Club Events

Events, other than those listed on this page, should be referred, by letter or e-mail, to the Membership Department of the BMF, giving full details of the event and allowing as much time as possible, before the event, to enable consultation with the Insurers.
